INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING TO MITCHELL COLLEGE

Mitchell College seeks students who are committed to learning. The Admissions Committee carefully reviews each application individually and selects candidates who possess the motivation and potential for academic success.

To apply, please submit the following information:

- ◆ A Completed Application for Admission – Students may complete this booklet or apply on-line by visiting www.mitchell.edu.
- ◆ \$30 non-refundable application fee attached to the front of your application. Make your check or money order payable to Mitchell College. Please write the applicant's name on the check.
- ◆ Official high school and college transcripts
- ◆ SAT or ACT scores – not required
- ◆ A letter of recommendation from your guidance counselor or teacher
- ◆ Your Personal Statement (a short essay, poem, coll ge, cassette, video, etc. that conveys who you are, your goals or your interest in studying at Mitchell College).

LRC APPLICANTS:

Students applying to the Learning Resource Center who wish to receive support for a documented learning disability and/or ADHD should submit the following information:

- ◆ Results of a complete psychoeducational evaluation
- ◆ Standardized achievement testing (reading, writing & math)
- ◆ Testing accommodations recommendations made by the professional who completed the evaluation
- ◆ A definitive diagnosis of a learning disability or ADHD

All documentation should be less than three years old, and all testing administered by a certified or licensed psychologist.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT APPLICANTS:

International students seeking admission to the ESL Program or one of our degree programs, must also submit the following:

- ◆ TOEFL scores (or other documentation on your English proficiency) if English is not your first language.
- ◆ An affidavit of financial support and official bank statement demonstrating the ability to meet the educational and living expenses required for one year of study in the United States.

THAMES ACADEMY™ APPLICANTS:

Students seeking admission to Thames Academy - Mitchell's one-year PG program, must check the 'Thames Academy' boxes on page 4 and page 8. SAT or ACT scores are not required. A personal interview, however, is required.
